

VOLUNTEER EXAMINER APPLICATION

Part 97 Para. 97.31

- (a) Each Volunteer Examiner administering an examination for Amateur Radio operators license must:
- (1) Be at least 18 years of age; and
 - (2) Not be related to the candidate.
- (b) Each Volunteer shall be uncompensated for his/her services.
- (c) Each Volunteer administering an examination for any class of radio amateur License must be accredited by the Volunteer-Examiner Coordinator (See subpart I).
- (d) The FCC will not accept the services of any person seeking to be a volunteer examiner if that person's amateur radio station license or amateur radio station operator license has ever been revoked or suspended.

Amateur Extra Class volunteers may administer examinations for all classes of license; Advanced and General Class licensees may administer examinations for Technician Class licenses; Advanced Class Licensees may also administer General Class examinations.

The V.E.C. reserves the right to deny or to remove accreditation from an examiner at will.
